THE GAMES PARK, THE «BEATING HEART» OF THE OLYMPIC CELEBRATION

Located in the heart of the Georges-Valbon Departmental Park, a green lung of 410 hectares and the largest park in Île-de-France classified as Natura 2000, is the largest celebration site in France for the Paris 2024 Games. The flagship of the festive programming for the general public is open from July 25 to August 11 during the Olympics, and from September 6 to 8 during the Paralympics. Spanning 8 hectares, it can accommodate up to 10,000 people for the evening concerts, free of charge.

Don't miss the park's opening on July 25, featuring the arrival of the Olympic Flame, which will pass through the park on its penultimate stop in Seine-Saint-Denis, the day before the opening ceremony on the Seine on July 26. This event, along with the competitions, will be broadcast on the Park's giant screen. But that's not all-there will also be concerts, cultural and sports activities, demonstrations, and plenty of food to satisfy your hunger. After all, sports can work up an appetite !
